## From the Desk of Rev. Erin Kobs, Organizational Presbyter & Stated Clerk

Friends,

As the trees begin to change & we begin to enter into this next season, I am reminded of where I was 24 years ago this week. I was a junior at Maryville College in Tennessee, taking a heavy load of classes for my major & serving as a resident assistant in a freshman all girls residence hall. Tuesday, September 11<sup>th</sup> was like another day at school, getting up early for my 9:30am American Sign Language class. For some reason, I had the television on & watching the Today Show. As I was getting ready, I was listening to the breaking news out of New York City. I turned to look & watched the second plane go into the World Trade Center. The feelings of disbelief & horror washed over me. We still went to class having to figure out a way to explain what happened to our professor, who was deaf. Classes were cancelled for the rest of the day. Students gathered around televisions to see what was going on. Resident assistant met to put a plan together on how to be supportive of our residents, especially those who had connections to New York & Washington, DC. It was such a surreal time - the fear, the uncertainty, the sadness. We worried about our close proximity to a nuclear plant in Oak Ridge, TN. The day ended with a chapel service, all of us crammed into our little chapel in the middle of campus, huddled together to pray & to be with one another. The days that followed were simply a blur. I cannot remember much, but knowing that I wanted to be close to my friends & my campus to be supportive, as we all tried to come to grips with our new reality.

Just 9 months before, I was traveling in Western Turkey, a predominantly Muslim country. I learned about their culture & the people, who all treated us with such kindness & welcome. That fall semester, I was in a Middle Eastern Culture class with several others from our study abroad trip. Our professor asked us to share our experiences with our classmates in an effort to remind them that not all Muslims are terrorists. It was a profound experience that has shaped me in deep ways.

Life changed on September 11, 2001. We all can remember where we were on that day & the days that followed. The closeness of the crash down near Shanksville brings it even closer to home for so many of us. As of the writing of this article, the 24<sup>th</sup> anniversary is tomorrow. For those who escaped these horrible attacks, lost loved ones, co-workers & friends - let us remember them, as they re-live it all during this time of year. For those who died, let us remember them. For all of us, let us find ways to come together & ways to be kind to one another. Our differences should not really matter in the end, but that we are all beloved children of God.

## Mandated Reporter Trainings

A reminder that the Book of Order does require that elders, ministers, & volunteers (Sunday school teachers, VBS workers, anyone who is working directly with children) every **36 months** (G-3.0106). This is a change from the past, when it was every 5 years, which is still the requirement for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Mandated Reporter training takes about an hour & a half. There is the option to do Zoom for these. The Zoom link will be emailed to all registered participants on **the day of the training**.

## Clearances

- **Mandated Reporter Training** (Child Abuse Prevention) - all ministers, elders, deacons & volunteers who work with children. Certificates are good for 36 months.
- **Boundary Training** - all ministers & elders. Must be done every 36 months (according to the Book of Order)
- **FBI Fingerprint Clearance** - all ministers. Certificates are good for five years (in accordance with PA state law & Presbytery policy)
- **PA State Police Clearance** - all ministers & those who work directly with children. Clearance is good for five years (PA state law), but are highly recommended to be done every 3 years for protection of our churches.



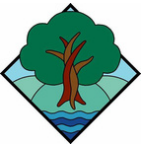

## 2025-2027 Book of Order & Presbyterian Planning Calendars

## PA Annual Report

Beginning in 2025, churches will need to complete an Annual Report with the state of Pennsylvania in order to maintain their non-profit status & tax-exempt status. **Filing after June 30<sup>th</sup>, there will be a fee.** Continued non-compliance could result in your church falling out of "good standing" or even administrative dissolution by the state.

- Churches need to update their contact information & report on who their corporate officers are for their "Corporation" (i.e. president, secretary & treasurer)
- The corporate officers must be properly elected by the session (unicameral board) or Trustees (bicameral board) & documented in your minutes. If your church has not elected officers recently, you need to begin the process & duly elect them before filing the Annual Report.

## Insurance Reimbursement Fund

Does your church have Guide One Insurance?

The Presbytery has a fund to help reimburse your deductible when you have an insurance claim. This is not just claims from storm damage. If you have a claim, you can send in your information regarding your claim for the Presbytery to review. The reimbursement will be for \$500.00.

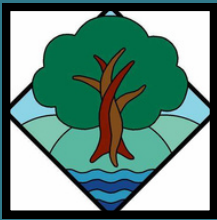
## Information about Records

In compliance with the Book of Order (G.3.0107), official records of active congregations and other records of permanent value, including registers; minutes of session, trustees, and other church groups; charters and property records; publications; and photographs.
